Introduction

The Alice Kane Award is an annual award presented by Storytelling Toronto in memory of Alice Kane (1908 – 2003). One of the co-founders of The Storytellers School of Toronto, Alice was a much beloved storyteller whose mastery of the art of storytelling made her an inspiration for many. The award is offered annually to a person or persons who wish to advance the art of storytelling through research, innovative projects, or through their own personal development as a storyteller.

Conditions of the Award

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1. Applicants must be supporters of Storytelling Toronto or Storytellers of Canada – Conteurs du Canada.
2. Submit an article to STT for publication in Pippin describing your experience within three months of its completion.
3. Make a public presentation within a year of completion of your project/program, at the Toronto Storytelling Festival, a house concert, or local gathering.

Applicants will be judged based on the following criteria:

- Presentation and description of project (quality and clarity) (10 points)
- Creativity and innovation (5 points)
- Budget (5 points)
- Impact on community/ significance of the project (5 points)
- Anticipated personal growth (5 points)
